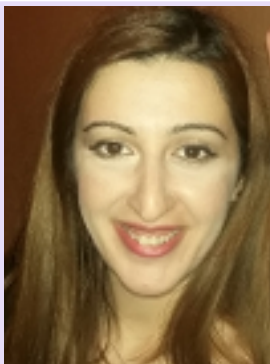

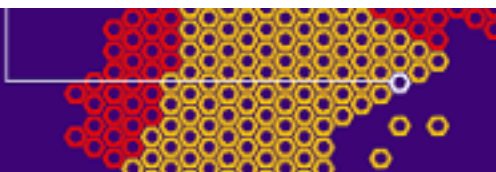
- How professionals structure engaging, stimulating, inspiring, persuasive and effective presentations

PG COURSE IN CLINICAL ENDOCRINOLOGY IN ZAGREB



Exceptional and thought-provoking clinical issues were the focus of the **Postgraduate Course in Clinical Endocrinology** that took place in Croatia's capital Zagreb from 23-24 March 2018. The training course, organized each year by the Zagreb University School of Medicine, gathered 134 participants from 20 different countries.

The course structure was based on meet-the-expert sections covering some interesting clinical issues in endocrinology, such as pituitary disorders in pregnancy, risk and benefits of testosterone replacement, bariatric surgery in the treatment of diabetes and endocrinology of opiates. "Meet-the-expert" sessions were held by distinguished speakers, while young endocrinologists had the opportunity to participate in the workshops by presenting some exciting clinical cases. There was plenty of time for discussion, which allowed the participants an opportunity for interaction and learning.

An affordable course fee and accommodation grants reserved for EYES members make this conference accessible and attractive for many young European endocrinologists.
