

# IMPORTANT MEDICAL INFO



**THIS PATIENT LACKS PARATHYROID HORMONE  
AND IS AT RISK FOR HYPOCALCEMIC AND  
HYPERCALCEMIC CRISES.**

In case of serious illness, nausea, vomiting and/or cramps, check serum calcium and kidney function.

If hypocalcemia and tetany, administer i.v. 2.5-5 mmol calcium chloride or gluconate (~ 100-200 mg elemental calcium) in 100 mL saline or glucose solution over 10 min. Repeat if needed.

If hypercalcemia  $> 3.5$  mmol/L (14.0 mg/dL), administer saline intravenously and admit the patient immediately to hospital.
